

Privacy Notice

At Embracing Age we are committed to protecting and respecting your privacy. This Policy explains when and why we collect personal information about people, how we use it, and how we keep it secure. We may change this Policy from time to time so please check this page occasionally to ensure that you're happy with any changes.

Who are we?

Embracing Age is a faith inspired charity registered in England and Wales (no. 1160400) working towards a world where older people are valued, connected and full of hope. We do this by mobilising volunteers to befriend care home residents, supporting informal carers and equipping churches in their work amongst older people.

How do we collect information about you?

We obtain information about you when you sign up for our newsletter, prayer letter or annual update on our website, or download one of our resources, or when you email us.

What type of information is collected about you?

The personal information we collect might include your name and email address. If you are looking to volunteer with us we will also collect further information including your telephone number, age, motivation for volunteering and contact details of your referees.

How is your personal information used?

We may use your information to:

- Process a volunteer application.
- Answer a query from yourself
- Send you information you have requested or information that we think you have a legitimate interest in.

We review our retention periods for personal information on a regular basis. We are legally required to hold some types of information to fulfil our statutory obligations (for example the collection of Gift Aid). We will hold your personal information on our systems for as long as is necessary for the relevant activity.

Who has access to your information?

Your information is stored securely in our online database.

We will not sell or rent your information to third parties.

We will not share your information with third parties for marketing purposes.

Your Rights

You have a choice about whether or not you wish to receive information from us. We will only send you information if there is a legitimate interest or you have specifically asked us to send you something (like our newsletter or prayer letter). If you would rather not receive communication from us you can ask us to stop at any time.

If we transfer your information outside of the EU in this way, we will take steps to ensure that appropriate security measures are taken with the aim of ensuring that your privacy rights continue to be protected as outlined in this Policy.
