

## Volunteer Role Description – Clothing Project Volunteers

<b>Roles:</b>	Liaising with people donating clothes, sort clothing, package clothing, distribute donated clothing, collect hangers, related admin
<b>Where:</b>	Across the London Borough of Richmond
<b>When:</b>	1-2 hours once a week.
<b>Why:</b>	Older people in care homes are potentially some of the most vulnerable people in our society. Research shows that there is a great need for clothing for residents and carers who come to care homes as they may not have family and friends locally to support them.
<b>What does the role involve:</b>	This is a varied role which can be fitted around your availability as well as the clothing donors'. Working as part of a team. Sorting, organising and distributing clothing packages.
<b>Attributes / skills needed:</b>	Be reliable Good organisation skills Be friendly and presentable
<b>What's in it for you?</b>	Meeting other like-minded volunteers. The satisfaction of knowing that you are making a big difference in the life of a vulnerable person in your community. Valuable experience of volunteering.
<b>What you can expect from us:</b>	Training and induction before the role starts. Ongoing support from the Richmond co-ordinator Regular meetings with other volunteers.
