Adopting a Care Home

Our website has lots of tried and tested ideas for building links with your local care home and for being a blessing to the staff and residents, along with a free ebook to download. You don't need a large team or big funds as these ideas can all be adapted to suit your situation.

Care Home Friends Toolkit

We offer a free toolkit to help you mobilise trained volunteers to come alongside care home residents in friendship and support. We can also provide training sessions for your volunteers, including specialist training focussed on visiting residents with dementia.

Carers Connected

We facilitate weekly Zoom gatherings to give informal carers looking after a loved one the opportunity to chat and pray together, as well as a private Facebook group where informal carers can connect with each other.

Supporting Carers

Our website has free downloadable resources on how churches can care for carers in their church and community.

This includes a free course for churches on supporting carers of people living with dementia, with video talks and a workbook with discussion questions.

Webinars & Workshops
