Attributes / skills needed:	Be reliable and trustworthy Good writing skills
What's in it for you?	The satisfaction of knowing that you are making a big difference in the life of a vulnerable person in your community. Valuable experience of volunteering.
What you can expect from us:	Induction before the role starts. Ongoing support from the project co-ordinator Pre- agreed out of pocket travel expenses
