Role:	Helping set up Alexa devices to connect care home residents with their loved ones in partnership with Auris
Where:	Across the Isle of Wight
When:	1 to 2 hours once a week as and when required. Flexible.
Why:	Alexa devices will enable voice activated connections, which are particularly helpful where a care home resident can't manage to use a mobile phone or iPad for example. Enabling them to connect with loved ones and use other helpful tools on the Alexa device.
What does the role involve:	In partnership with Auris help set up Alexa devices in care homes for a resident and their relative. To assist with training individuals in its uses.
Attributes / skills needed:	Be reliable and trustworthy Have a good understanding of Alexa technology Good communication skills Patience, kindness and empathy
What's in it for you?	The satisfaction of knowing that you are making a big difference in the life of a vulnerable person in your community. Valuable experience of volunteering.
What you can expect from us:	Training and induction before the role starts. Ongoing support from the project co-ordinator and Auris lead partner. Pre- agreed out of pocket travel expenses
